



## Rules for Medhā Camp (July 16, 2017 – July 30, 2017)

- 1) All participants are expected to stay in the campsite all through the camp. They are allowed to leave the campsite only after taking permission from their counselor and if accompanied by a parent/guardian or a counselor. *One day off from the camp would be allowed from 4:30pm on Friday July 21, 2017 to 6:00pm on Saturday, July 22, 2017.* Students may avail of this opportunity, but only if granted permission in advance by the parents and the details regarding the local guardian sent by email to [medhaa@sanskritabharatiusa.org](mailto:medhaa@sanskritabharatiusa.org)
- 2) Possession or use of alcoholic beverages, cigarettes(including electronic models) or illicit drugs in the camp will not be permitted. Camper's luggage will be inspected prior to the beginning or any time during the camp, to ensure that no prohibited material is brought to the camp.
- 3) Gambling, fighting, harassment of others, use of indecent/threatening language shall not be tolerated.
- 4) Campers will stay in their allotted cabins. Boys and girls are not allowed in each other's cabins. Campers are expected to be in their rooms and stay quiet from 10:00 pm – 6 am.
- 6) Campers are expected to dress and conduct themselves in an appropriate manner.
- 7) Campers are expected to keep the campsite clean at all times. This includes their rooms, dining area, activity areas and the playgrounds.
- 8) Campers are expected to be considerate and courteous towards the Aksharam office staff and other students.
- 9) All campers must participate in all planned activities unless excused by their counselor.
- 10) No electronic devices are permitted in the classroom. Those students wishing to record the class need to obtain permission from their counselor or teacher beforehand.
- 11) Campers with any medical problems requiring special medical attention / medication must inform their counselor immediately upon arrival. Campers experiencing any medical problems during the camp are expected to consult with a counselor.
- 12) Campers are required to be present for any scheduled check-in set by counselors.
- 13) Parents/guardians are responsible for transportation to/from the camp site during arrival to/departure from the camp. If pick up or drop off is needed for the participant, the parent/guardian should coordinate it with the camp organizers.
- 14) Campers are expected to comply with all rules of the campsite.

**Failure to comply with any of the above-mentioned rules/regulations will result in immediate expulsion from the camp (Parents will be responsible for taking children back).**
